2019 PRESENTATION DAY TICKETS

The Concert/Presentation Days for 2019 will be held at the Griffith Regional Theatre on the following days:

- K-2 - Tuesday 3 December 2019 at 10.00 a.m.
- 3-6 – Tuesday 10 December 2019 at 10.00 a.m.

Following consultation with and endorsement by the GEPS P & C Association the ticket allocation system introduced last year will continue this year.

Tickets will either be available as doubles (2 seats together) or a single seat and will be selected and allocated randomly.

An order form will also be provided in the newsletter next week to be returned on or after 4 November. This system is being implemented to avoid the long queues which have occurred in past years.

Tickets will be sent home in an envelope with your child (or you can request to collect them from the office from Wednesday 6 Nov).

If you have not received your tickets by Friday 8 November please contact the school office.

The cost of the ticket covers the hire of the theatre and bus travel for the students for both the rehearsal and presentation day.

As we have done in the past few years, tickets will be limited to 2 tickets per family for each presentation day for the first week of sales (4 Nov- 8 Nov 2019). This policy has also been endorsed by the P & C Association.

Commencing 11 November additional tickets may be available for families. The process for obtaining additional tickets will be in the newsletter at a later date if tickets are available.

This process allows all families an opportunity to obtain tickets during the first week of sales.

It is important that you access your 2 tickets during the first week of sales if you wish to attend.
