REMINDER - ANAPHYLAXIS SUPPORT AND PROCEDURES

All staff have been trained in the management of anaphylaxis reactions. This training has taken place to support and protect the health and safety of students at risk of anaphylaxis when they are at school or involved in school activities.

We have a number of students who have been prescribed an epi-pen and the school also has its own epi-pens in our first aid kits.

Key strategies to minimise the risk of allergic reactions in students are:

- **Students do not share food with each other**
- **Wash your hands after eating or touching food**
- **Know what your friends are allergic to**
- **Don't pressure your friends to eat what they are allergic to**
- **If a friend or student becomes sick or unwell get teacher/adult help immediately**
