ENROL NOW FOR KINDERGARTEN 2020

We are now accepting enrolments for Kindergarten 2020. Children who turn 5 before 31 July 2020 are eligible for enrolment in Kindergarten.

Applications for non-local enrolments are considered using a range of criteria, including the availability of appropriate staff and classroom accommodation. Please contact the Principal if you require further information about the procedures for non-local enrolment. Parents are encouraged to seek enrolment in their local zoned school.

If you would like to discuss readiness for school or any other matters regarding enrolling your child please make an appointment with the school office to see Mrs Kylie Mulholland who is our Assistant Principal looking after Kindergarten.

The school will be conducting a pre enrolment/orientation meeting for parents later in the year to outline our kindergarten orientation program which operates in Term 4.
