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HEALTHY CANTEEN

The NSW Healthy Canteen Strategy aims to support student health by providing access to healthy foods and drinks to make the healthy choice the easy choice.

During Term 3 2019 we will be making adjustments to our canteen menu to ensure that **75% of our menu is Everyday Foods and Drinks** and **25% is Occasional Foods and Drinks**.

Everyday foods and meals are those made from the 5 food groups and drinks are water and milk.

Occasional foods and drinks are generally higher in saturated fat, sugars or salt, with less nutritional value than Everyday foods. Maximum portion sizes will apply.

Menu adjustments will be advertised in the newsletter as they occur and once the full menu has been approved by the NSW Health Dept it will be sent home. The new menu will clearly identify Everyday Foods and Drinks as well as Occasional Foods and Drinks.
