More information about multi-age classes (composite classes)

Composite classes will have students from two year groups in the same class. The school has established these classes due to the uneven pattern of enrolment in the school. The school takes great care in ensuring that every student is placed in a class that best meets his/her needs. Factors such as learning and social benefits are of prime importance. Research show multi-age classes may benefit students both socially and emotionally.

Multi-age classes are designed to match the organisation of the syllabus, which is based on 'stages' running over two years. In 2025 the school will fund an additional class to avoid cross stage composite classes.

It would be appreciated if you could advise the school office by the end of this week if you are moving away from Griffith at the end of the year and your child will not be attending GEPS in 2024.
