SEMESTER ONE STUDENT REPORTS

For the first time, this year student academic reports will be sent home electronically. Parents will receive an email on Monday 30 June, after 2pm. If you don't receive an email with your child's report, by Tuesday morning, please contact the school to let us know. Reports will also be uploaded to School Bytes. You will find the report in the resources section of the parent portal, from Tuesday 1 July.

Your child's report will still show their progress across all subject areas.

For students 1-6, teacher comments will appear in English, mathematics and the general comment section, in line with Department of Education policy. Kindergarten reports will include a comment for all key learning areas including, creative arts, HSIE, PDHPE, science and technology.

A new achievement scale and descriptions are included to provide a clearer picture of your child's progress.

Parent-teacher interviews remain an important way to discuss your child's progress and achievement in more detail. These can be requested following Semester 1 and 2 reports. We encourage you to ring the school to make an appointment with the classroom teacher, if you would like a parent-teacher interview.
